## OSCE Checklist: Examination of a Neck Lump

Introduction	
Introduce yourself	
Wash hands	
Briefly explain to the patient what the examination involves	
Inspection	
Ensure adequate exposure and the patent is looking straight ahead	
At rest:	
- Obvious lumps	
- Scars or skin changes	
If mass noted at rest:	
- Ask patient to stick tongue out	
- Ask patient to swallow	
Palpate	
Lymph nodes	
- Submental, Submandibular, Pre-auricular, Anterior Cervical,	
Supraclavicular, Posterior Cervical, Post-Auricular, and Occipital	
Parotid gland	
Submandibular gland	
Thyroid gland	
Completing the examination	
Thank the patient	
To complete the examination:	
- US scan and FNA of any lump identified (unless pulsatile)	
- An examination of the temporomandibular joint
