- Pull the external ear superiorly and posteriorly	
Tympanic Membrane	
Inspect the tympanic membrane for:	
- Lateral process of malleus	
- Cone of light	
- Pars tensa and pars flaccida	
Assessment of Hearing	
Rinne Test (512Hz tuning fork)	
- Place near the external ear canal	
- Then place against the mastoid process	
Weber Test Test (512Hz tuning fork)	
- Place on the forehead in the midline	
Completing the Examination	
Thank the patient	
To complete the examination:	
- Tympanogram	
- Pure tone audiometry
